

Come See What God Is Doing In...

Ibarra, Ecuador

October 14-22 (Fri – Sat)

Moulton Baptist Church

The charming colonial town of Ibarra is in the Andes Mountains, only a two-hour drive from Quito. The city's elevation is 7000 feet. Many of Ibarra's houses are built in the colonial style and their red-tiled roofs and whitewashed walls have given Ibarra the nickname of "The White City". The population is approximately 110,000. October temperatures are in the 60's during the day and 40's at night.

Purpose: The purpose of our trip is to work side-by-side with Ecuadorian Christians to win people in their city to Christ, to help disciple those new believers and to bring them together to form a new church as they study the Bible and reach out to more areas of the city to start even more churches.

"But I don't speak Spanish." E3 provides a translator for each team member.

How will I know what to do? E3 Staff will train you completely before the trip and provide all the resources you need. You will receive materials to read to make you familiar with what we are working to accomplish.

How do I apply: Visit **G_Oe3.net** then click "Go Now". Complete the application along with a \$200 deposit.

Documents needed: Passport with at least six months left before expiration. A link to the forms can be found at G_Oe3.net

Trip Cost: Approximately **\$2,420** which covers everything but travel day meals and souvenirs. E3 will teach you how to enlist a prayer team and raise support. Sample support letters can be found at G_Oe3.net. Frequent Flier miles may be used if available..

Day-by-day: The first day you will go out with a team member, translators and local church members to share the gospel door-to-door in the target community for a new church. In the evening you will help with a fun time as the new believers gather to build relationships and read the Bible. During that time, some of you will lead programs for the children. On the following days you will continue evangelism, return to the homes of the new believers to disciple them and build relationships.
